#### **BILLING SCHEDULE**

Blackbaud Tuition Management will email your monthly bill 10 days before your selected payment date. The first bill of the academic year is sent in July. Late charges are assessed on unpaid balances before the next billing. If there is no balance due and no transactions during the month, a bill will not be sent. Payments for incidental charges are added to your Blackbaud Tuition Management account.

#### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial Aid awards at Stephen's and St. Agnes are based upon need as determined by the impartial judgment of the school and TADS. Financial Assistance decisions are independent of admission decisions. Parents may review Financial Assistance application information on our website at sssas.org in the Admission section, or from Jill Iverson in the Admission Office at jiverson@sssas.org. The school encourages parents requiring tuition assistance to complete an online Financial Assistance application, including an upload of their most recent IRS Form 1040 and W2 by November 1.

#### OTHER FEES

**Advanced Placement Test Fees:** AP Exams are administered to Upper School students near the end of each school year. There is an approximate \$90 charge for each advanced placement test taken.

**Athletic Equipment Charges:** Fee for the purchase or rental of athletic equipment and uniforms to be used in a student's elected sport(s) beginning in the seventh grade.

**Blackbaud Tuition Management Enrollment Fees**: Charged by Blackbaud Tuition Management. The annual \$50 enrollment fee is charged once per family.

**Books & Supplies:** Middle and Upper Schools – families will acquire over the summer. Book lists will be posted on the MBS Direct website in early July. Estimated costs range from \$250-600 per year. More information will be provided through pushpages from the division directors in May and June.

**Field Trip Fees**: Covers the entry and/or transportation fees associated with curriculum-required or optional school field trips in grades 9-12. The school's practice is to send a note home in advance with specific trip logistics and costs. The school does not charge field trip fees to students in grades JK-8.

**Global Engagement Trips:** Students in the Upper School are offered opportunities to participate in service based or course credit trips during Spring Break or early June. More information is available in October on the trips being offered. The cost of the trip selected is added to your student account less the registration deposit and spread out over several months.

**Late Fees**: Contracts submitted after the due date (February 4, 2024) will be subject to a \$1000 late fee, without a pre-approved deadline extension. The billing system will charge parents a monthly late fee whenever there is a balance at the end of the month. The amount of the monthly late fee will be \$40 per month.

**Mini-Course Trips:** Students in the eighth grade are offered the opportunity to participate in service based mini-course trips in the Spring. Last year's trips included Puerto Rico and New Orleans. The fees range from \$1,000-\$3,000 per student. The fee pays for travel, accommodations, and the majority of meals. The cost of the trip selected is added to your student account less the registration deposit and spread out over several months.

**Performing Arts Trip**: Students who participate in the Upper School Performing Arts groups may choose to participate in a bi-annual trip. The fee is \$900-\$1,200/student. The fee pays for travel expenses, accommodations, a majority of meals, ticket and entrance fees. The charge will be billed to the student accounts in multiple installments, between October and January.

**School Store Supplies and Clothes**: Students are permitted to shop in the school's store and make cash purchases or charge items to their student accounts. The school recommends that each family talk with its student about its family policy regarding use of a charge account.

**Summer Reading Books:** All students in grades K-12 receive summer reading lists. We encourage parents of students in grades K-5 to utilize their local libraries and students in grades 6-8 to purchase the books at a discount bookstore. For students in grades 9-12, the list will include the title, author, publisher, required edition, and ISBN Number. Students and parents/guardians are encouraged to purchase through an internet provider or at a retail bookstore.

#### ADDITIONAL SERVICES

#### SCHOOL STORE

The school operates a store on different days on the Lower and Upper School campuses. It stocks a full supply of "Saints" clothing and school supplies throughout the school year. During the school year, the School Store operates as follows:

Upper School on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:00-4:00 Lower School on Thursday from 8:00-4:00 Tuesday by appointment

During the summer months, the School Store is open by appointment. Call 703-212-2755. In addition, the school has an online store at <u>sssasstore.com</u>. The online store stocks apparel and spirit items.

#### TRANSPORTATION

The school provides free between-campus shuttles and shuttle service to and from the King Street Metro Station. One-way and round-trip commuter bus service to and from school is available for \$1,470 and \$2,320 respectively. #### **LUNCH PROGRAM**

Students in grades ES-8 may choose to bring their own lunch or enroll in the annual lunch program, catered by SAGE Dining (<u>sagedining.com</u>). SAGE strives to provide nutritious and sustainably-sourced food options that many of our students enjoy.

#### **EXTENDED DAY PROGRAMS - LOWER SCHOOL**

**Extended Day for Grades ES-5:** Before/After School Supervision is offered for Early Saints through fifth grade on an annual or drop-in/hourly basis.

#### **AFTER CARE**

Extended Day care is offered to all students four years and older, in grades ES-5 on an annual or limited drop-in hourly basis. Parents of students in grades ES-5 needing drop-in care are required to make a reservation by calling the extended day office (703-212-2758) at least 24 hours in advance. An after-school snack is included.

#### AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

A wide variety of after school enrichment activities are offered to students by the trimester. Fees vary and parents may sign up at the beginning of each trimester.

#### MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDY CLUB

Middle School Study Club offers students in grades 6-8 the opportunity to complete homework, receive study assistance, and relax and eat snack in a supervised, classroom-based study hall setting. The service is available on a trimester basis from 3:15-6:00 p.m. Middle School families may choose to sign up their student from 3:15-4:30 p.m. or 3:15-6:00 p.m. From 3:15-4:30 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, a math teacher will be available to assist students with any questions or assignments.

#### PAYMENT PLANS

## A. Full payment by cash, check or money order directly to the school or Blackbaud Tuition Management is due by July 1

A rebate of \$250 is available if payment of the full annual tuition is received in the Business Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on June 30, 2024 or scheduled to be paid in full through Blackbaud Tuition Management in July. The rebate is not available to families receiving financial assistance from the school.

#### B. Payment plans through Blackbaud Tuition Management

Semi-annual, quarterly, and monthly payments are made via automatic bank payments or by credit card. Monthly plans may begin as early as July 2024 or as late as September 2024 and payments must be complete by June 2024.
